### **Genuine Fellowship Happen When...** (Building Blocks)

#### 1. Authenticity.

Let love be without hypocrisy. Abhor what is evil; cling to what is good. **Romans 12:9** (NASB)

But if we live in the light, as God is in the light, we can share fellowship with each other. Then the blood of Jesus, God's Son, cleanses us from every sin. If we say we have no sin, we are fooling ourselves, and the truth is not in us. **1 John 1:7-8** (NCV)

#### 2. Courtesy.

Be devoted to one another in brotherly love.

#### 3. Mutuality.

Be joyful in hope, patient in affliction, faithful in prayer.

If one person falls, the other can reach out and help. But someone who falls alone is in real trouble. Ecclesiastes 4:10 (NLT)
